

Cheadle Hulme Nursery Admissions Policy

This Admissions Policy is in place to ensure parents/carers and staff understand the process for the allocation of places at Cheadle Hulme Nursery (CHN). The Laurus Trust is the Admissions Authority for places at Cheadle Hulme Nursery. CHN offers pre-school provision for children in the academic year before they start school.

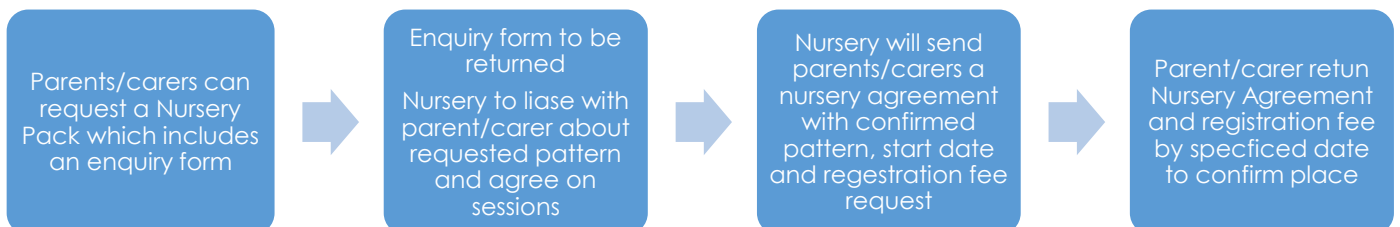

September 2020 to July 2021	1 September 2016 to 31 August 2017
September 2021 to July 2022	1 September 2017 to 31 August 2018
September 2022 to July 2023	1 September 2018 to 31 August 2019
September 2023 to July 2024	1 September 2019 to 31 August 2020

At CHN we offer full and part time childcare provision and will where possible, accommodate parental requests. CHN is registered to care for children by Ofsted, under the Early Years Welfare Requirements.

From September 2017, entitlement to 30 hours free childcare is available to eligible parents. This funding is intended to support working parents with the cost of childcare and enable parents, where they wish, to return to work or to work additional hours.

Applications

- Places will be offered on availability basis, reflecting the sessions required.
- If we are unable to meet your request for the sessions required, alternative sessions will be offered if available.
- Places are secured with the return of a Nursery Agreement and registration fee.
- If the alternatives offered are not suitable, you will be given the option of joining the waiting list.
- The waiting list is reviewed on regular basis and places will be allocated as soon as a suitable vacancy arises.

Please be aware that a place in Cheadle Hulme Nursery **does not** guarantee a place at Cheadle Hulme Primary School. School admission are through Stockport Local Authority. For more information please click on the [link](#).

Waiting List

When there is more than one child on our waiting list, the over subscription criteria will be used to determine which order the children are ranked. Each application can fall into 1 category only.

Places on the waiting list will be allocated in the following order:

A - Children of staff employed by the Laurus Trust

B - Children with siblings and/or already in attendance at the Nursery (for a minimum of 30 hours per week)

C – Date by which the booking form was received by

Appeals

Parents and Carers have a right to appeal against any decision regarding admission to Cheadle Hulme Nursery. All appeals will be heard by a panel within 30 school days of receiving an appeal.
