### Absences in Term Time

Any planned absence must be requested in advance, for the attention of Mrs Drake. A reply will then be sent to you stating whether or not the reason given allows for the absence to be authorised or not. You may be asked to come into school to discuss your child's attendance if we have concerns about the amount of time they are missing. The Government expects schools and Local Authorities to promote good attendance and reduce absence, including persistent absence and to act early to address patterns of absence. If the absence is unauthorised and you choose to proceed with the absence, then the school has a duty to inform the Local Authority who may impose a Fixed Penalty Fine.
