We are delighted to share some of the highlights from our recent Parent Carer Survey with you:

- 98% of parents/carers strongly agree or agree that their child is happy at school
- 98% strongly agree or agree that their child feels safe at school
- 96% strongly agree or agree the school ensures pupils are well behaved
- 93% strongly agree or agree their child does well
- 87% strongly agree or agree we have high expectations of their child
- 87% strongly agree or agree there is a good range of subjects available to their child

It was really pleasing to see that 91% of parents and carers strongly agree or agree the school promotes an inspiring reading for pleasure culture as this is something we have been working particularly hard on. It was also gratifying to see that 89% of parents and carers strongly agree or agree the school supports their child's wider personal development as this is hugely important to us.

Next year we will be focusing on making sure parents and carers feel they know what their child is learning in school. A quarter of parents indicated that this was not the case and we want to improve on this.
