As you will know, there are a large number of measures currently in place to keep staff, children and parents safe in and around school and we thank you for your support in adhering to these.

Earlier this month, Stockport was added to the list of national 'areas of concern' and with the number of schools closing Bubbles due to confirmed cases on the increase, we feel that it is now a responsible decision and an appropriate time to ask that all parents and carers wear a mask whilst on school grounds for drop off and pick up. We would ask that this begin on Monday.

We would also like to take this opportunity to remind you of the importance of keeping to the following points:

- Please follow the one way system on site at all times regardless of your arrival and departure times
- Please keep to your designated start/end times (including not arriving too early for either) and make every effort to minimise your time on site
- Please keep your children with you at all times when on site, no children should be using the trim trail or main playground area before or after school
- Please maintain social distancing at all times when on site. If speaking to other parents or a member of school staff at drop off or pick up you must stay at least 2 metres from them
- Please support our efforts in school by ensuring you are abiding by broader government guidance outside of school

Thank you in advance for your cooperation in adhering to these measures. As ever, the safety of the community is our foremost concern.
