What to do if your child receives a positive test over half term

We have a responsibility to let other pupils and staff know who may have been in close contact with your child if they test positive for COVID-19 during the half term holiday. Please inform us of a positive test result and provide us with the below information as soon as possible by email via: admin@cheadlehulmeprimary.org.uk.

Please put "Positive COVID test" in the subject line and include the details listed below:

- Confirmation of positive test result
- Date of when your child was last in school
- Date of when your child developed COVID symptoms and what the symptoms were
- Date of COVID test
- Date of COVID test result
- Names of other pupils they have been in close contact with at social times in the 48 hours prior to the symptoms appearing or the date of the test
- Names of pupils they may have travelled to and from school with in the 48 hours prior to the symptoms appearing or the date of the test.
