Individual and Class photos have now been sent home. Please feel free to get in touch with the School Office if you need any help placing your order.

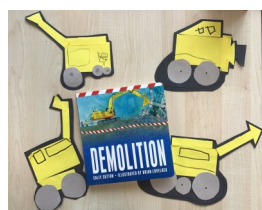
Nativity Costumes

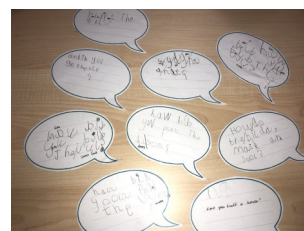
