CAR PARK

The overwhelming majority of parents accept that parking is not possible on school site and we thank you for respecting this.

The rules on this are as follows: **unless you hold a blue badge, there is no car access or parking on school grounds between the hours of 2-3.30pm.**

Of course this unfortunately means time always needs to be factored in to finding other places to park in order to get on site on time at the beginning and end of the day, but this is the case with the vast majority of schools.

It is not the job of school staff to police the car park - we would rather concentrate on running your child's school - and no parent has the right to be aggressive or rude to **any** member of the team enforcing what are very simple rules.

ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

Full attendance at school is critical not only for your child's academic success but also for their personal and social development.

Fines are typically issued by the Local Authority if a child has an unauthorised absence for 5 days or more. The first time a family incurs a fine it could be up to £160 per parent per child, a second will be at least this figure and any further instances could result in a criminal conviction.

There are exceptional circumstances in which short term time absences can be authorised but even these should of course be kept to a minimum. Should you need to request an absence, this must be submitted in writing to admin@theadleholmeprimary.org.uk **prior to taking the absence.**
