- Children must bring their water bottles in on the day; these will remain with them during the event.
- As it may be a warm day, sunscreen should be applied prior to the children coming into school and ideally sunhats should be worn
- The running track on the field will provide a natural marker for viewing as the events will happen within the oval - parents will be invited to move round the track as the children rotate around the events inside it.
