# Our use of Twitter/X

Twitter/X has never just been a method of communicating with parents/carers. It provides children with a platform to share success and celebrate achievements, it provides teachers with



ways of reaching authors and external organisations and it provides a vital record for us of what is happening across school in each subject. It is one of the windows into the day to day life of each of our classrooms and for that reason alone is why we value its use but must do so with care and consideration to protect the digital wellbeing of our children.

After careful consideration, from the end of this term we will be changing the way we use X for each of the year group handles e.g. @CHPSYR1. These feeds will have their permissions adjusted so that only approved followers are able to view Tweets (unless another user e.g. an author, has been specifically alerted to a post). The process of removing all followers and restricting access will take place over the coming week, during which time you may be notified of being 'removed' as a follower yourself. Once this process has been completed, we will communicate instructions on how to refollow and the way in which we will verify your identity as an approved follower.

The main school account @Cheadlehulmepri will continue to be used to share whole school celebrations, events and opportunities that pupils take part in throughout the year. We look forward to the evolution of how we use X to capture some of the ways in which we prepare our children for 'a world we know and a world yet to be discovered'.
