

Keeping our children safe

Thank you for 'doing your bit' to set a good example to others in efforts to keep our children's safety a priority. Notable examples include: dismounting from bikes/scooters on site, supervising children until the point they are inside the building at the start of the school day, parking considerately and respecting other road users and school staff who are only trying to help out in our car park - we are not trained parking attendants or traffic police.


World Book Day
