- Your child will be supported by Stockport's School Nurse Team (previously Health Visitor)

- Listening to and talking about stories



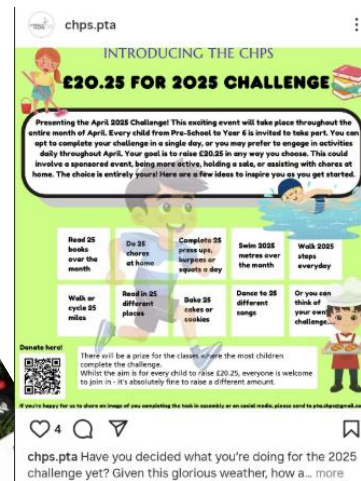
Show and tell

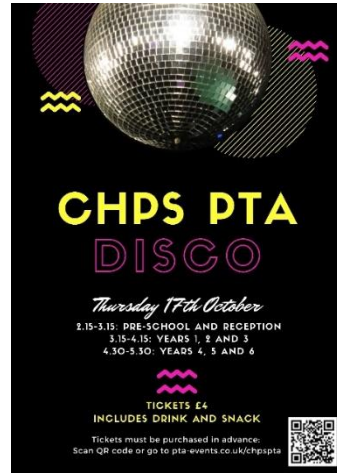
