Welcome to Reception! We are looking forward to the new school year and to sharing the start of your child's school journey with them. In preparation for September, please find some important information below, which will help prepare you and your child for Reception.

Reading

- 2 x individual school reading books will be taken home and your child will have the opportunity to swap their books once they have been read
- Please comment in your child's Reading Record when you have read with your child
- Your child's reading books and Reading Record should be brought into school each day
- Your child will take part in regular Guided Reading with their teacher

Home Learning

- The purpose of Home Learning is to consolidate and extend learning
- The activities are designed to be fun and engaging which your child may need support with.

Home School Communications

- The Reception team are available every morning and at the end of the school day
- Your child's Class Teacher should always be your first point of contact
- Feedback can be shared with PTA/Parent Council Reps and Parent Governors

Drop-off and Collection Arrangements

- Reception children will enter school through their own classroom door from the playground
- The children will be dismissed from their door onto the school playground, directly to their parent/carer. If the person collecting at the end of the day is different to usual, please inform the school's admin team before pick-up

Snack

- Government-funded fruit and milk scheme is provided for Reception children.
- A Milk alternative (we are a nut free school) can be brought into school in a small bottle or flask.
