

## Welcome to Year 1

Welcome to Year 1, we are looking forward to the start of a new school year and sharing all the great learning experiences we have in store for your child! Keeping you as parents/carers involved in your child's learning is very important to us, so we would like to share some important information with you:

### Reading

- 2 individual reading books to be recorded in the child's Reading Record
- Your Reading Response should be returned to school on your child's book changing day
- We will encourage you to comment in your child's Reading Record each time you read
- Your child will have the opportunity to read with their Teacher each week

### Home Learning

- The purpose of Home Learning is to consolidate and extend learning
- Children should be able to complete the tasks independently, but can be supported
- Home learning is often practical. Any written pieces can be returned to school in your child's reading response book
- Any concerns regarding Home Learning should be shared with the Class Teacher

### Home School Communications

- Your child's Class Teacher should always be your first point of contact
- The Year 1 Team are available every morning and at the end of the school day
- Reading Records and reading books to be sent home and returned to school daily
- Feedback can be shared with PTA/Parent Council Reps and Parent Governors

### Collection Arrangements

- The children will be dismissed via their Year 1 classroom door onto the playground
- If the person collecting at the end of the day changes, please inform the school's Admin Team
